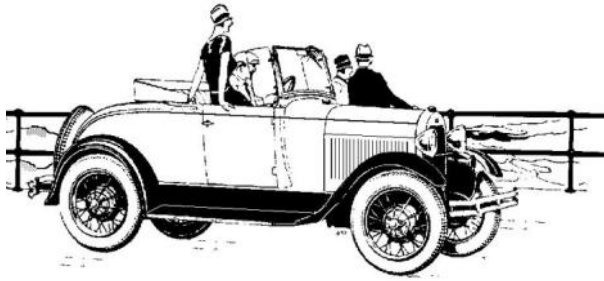

## Recipe Of The Month

*This recipe was in the June-July 2007 Phoenix Model A Newsletter. It sounds easy and good. I haven't tried it yet.*

### EASY BAKED FISH & CHIPS

- 1 large potato
- 1 Tbsp. Kraft Light Done Right Zesty Italian Reduced Fat Dressing
- 1/2 Pouch Shake & Bake Extra Crispy Seasoned Coating Mix
- 1/2 lb. white fish fillets, such as haddock, Halibut or cod
- 2 Tbsp. Miracle Whip Light Dressing

Preheat oven to 400 degrees F. Cut potatoes length-wise into 8 wedges. Toss potatoes with Italian dressing in bowl. Arrange, cut sides down, on large baking sheet coated with cooking spray. Bake 15 min.

Meanwhile, reserve 2 Tbsps. Of the coating mix for potatoes; set aside. Place remaining coating mix on a plate. Spread one side of fish fillets with half of the Miracle Whip dressing. Dip fish in coating mix. Turn over; brush other side of fish fillet with remaining dressing. Turn fish over to coat all sides well with coating mix.

Remove potatoes from oven, turn over and arrange around outer edge of baking sheet. Place fish in center of baking sheet. Sprinkle reserved 2 Tbsp. coating mix over potatoes.

Bake 15 min. or until fish flakes with fork and potatoes are tender. Serves two.

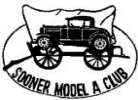
