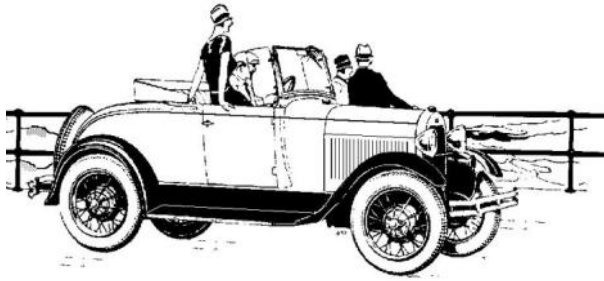

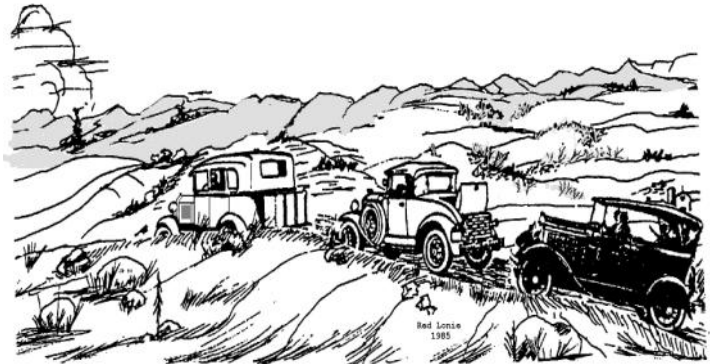

Recipe Of The Month

MOIST CARMEL APPLE CAKE

1 pkg (2 layer size) yellow cake mix
 1 pkg (4 serving size) Jell-O Vanilla or French Vanilla flavor Instant Pudding & Pie Filling
 3 Granny Smith apples, peeled, coarsely chopped
 1 C. water
 4 eggs
 1/3 C. vegetable oil
 20 Kraft Caramels, unwrapped
 1/4 C. Milk

Preheat oven to 350. Grease and flour a 12 C. fluted bundt pan or a 10" tube pan. Beat cake mix, dry pudding mix, water, eggs and oil in large bowl with electric mixer on low speed until blended. Beat on high speed 2 min. Gently stir in apples. Pour into prepared pan.

Bake 50 min. to 1 hour or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean. Cool 20 min; remove from pan.

Cool completely on wire rack.

Microwave caramels and milk in microwaveable bowl on HIGH 1-1/2 min. Stirring every 30 sec. until blended. Cool 10 min. until slightly tickened. Drizzle over cake.

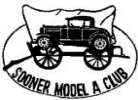
