Of course, Don Mitchell announced the highly anticipated passing of the Dumbbell Award to its new owner . I won’t go into who received it for obvious reasons.



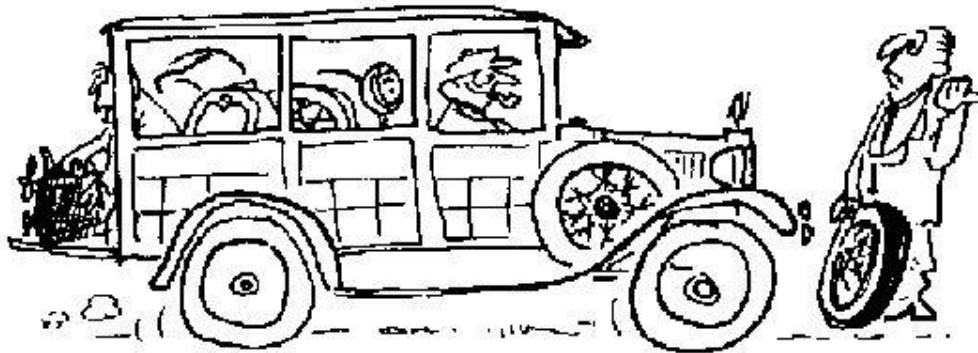
Johnny Gentry thanked the 2007 Board and members for all of their efforts and assistance during his year as President. Bill Jenkins presented

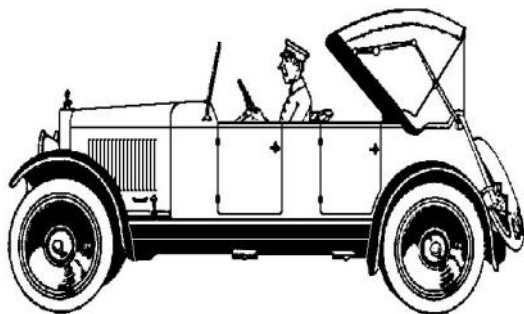

We would like members to wear era fashions or at least bring things you have and we will discuss what our information says are fashions from our era.

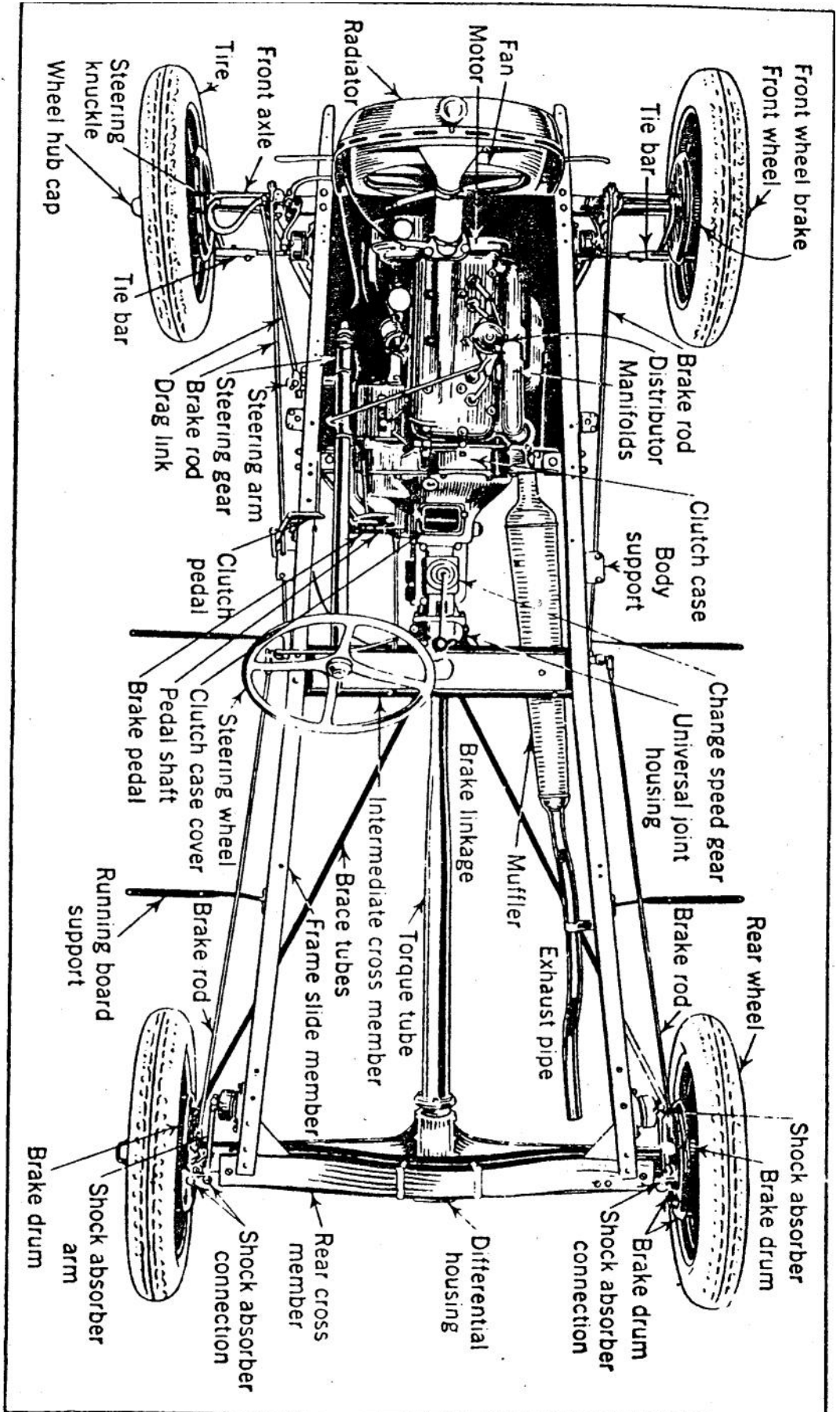


Figure 3-1 is a view of the chassis shown as an aid in locating the principal parts. The shroud shown behind the radiator was discontinued during 1928.
