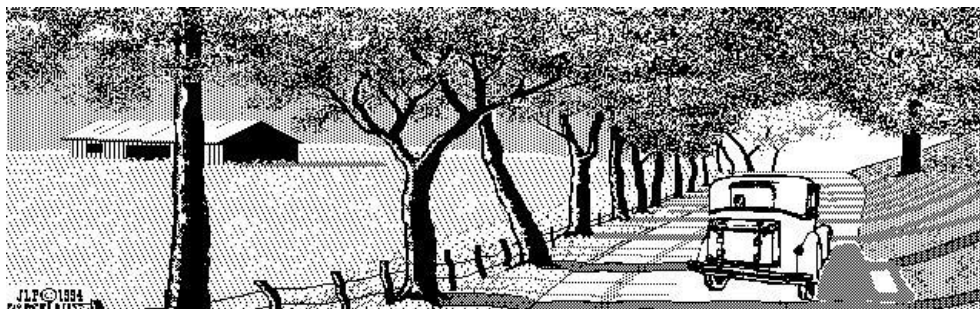

Think about it. Part of the joy of owning a Model A is in showing it to the public. How long has it been since you've enjoyed showing off your "pride and joy."

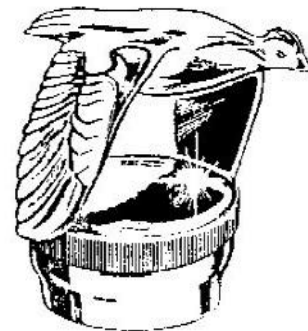

## PROPOSED BY-LAW CHANGES

### 1. ARTICLE I

Original: The name of this organization shall be the Sooner Model A Club.

Proposed: The name of this organization shall be the Sooner Model A Ford Club. (This is  
The original name of the club)

### 2. Change Article II as follows:

Original:

#### **ARTICLE II – PURPOSE**

SECTION 1. This organization will strive to unite, in a central organization, all owners of Model A Ford cars who are interested in restoring and maintaining the car in a manner to attract prestige and respect within the community.

SECTION 2. This organization will serve as a medium for the exchange of ideas, information, and parts for admirers of the Model A Ford car, and the parts for admirers of the Model A Ford car, and an aid in efforts to restore and preserve the car.

Proposed:

#### **ARTICLE II – PURPOSE**

SECTION 1. This organization will be composed of owners of Model A Ford cars and other persons who are interested in restoring and maintaining the car in a manner to attract prestige and respect within the community.

SECTION 2. This organization will serve as a medium for the exchange of ideas, information, and parts for owners and admirers of the Model A Ford car. It will also aid in efforts to restore and maintain the Model A Ford car.

### 3. ARTICLE V SECTION 4

Change membership dues from \$10.00 per year to \$20.00 per year.

Change second sentence to read:

“Members are encouraged to pay their national dues directly to the Model A Ford Club of America.”

### 4. ARTICLE V SECTION 9

Original: Two members of the outgoing Executive Council appointed by the President will review the status of the books.

Proposed: A newly elected Treasurer may request an audit of the books. After such request, two members of the outgoing Executive Board appointed by the President will review the status of the books.

5. **ARTICLE VII** says the president “shall” appoint certain committees. This sentence will be changed to read “should” appoint. It is sometimes impossible to get members to serve on these committees.

6. Correct typographical errors in last printing.

7. Change all references to the “Executive Council” to read the “Executive Board.”

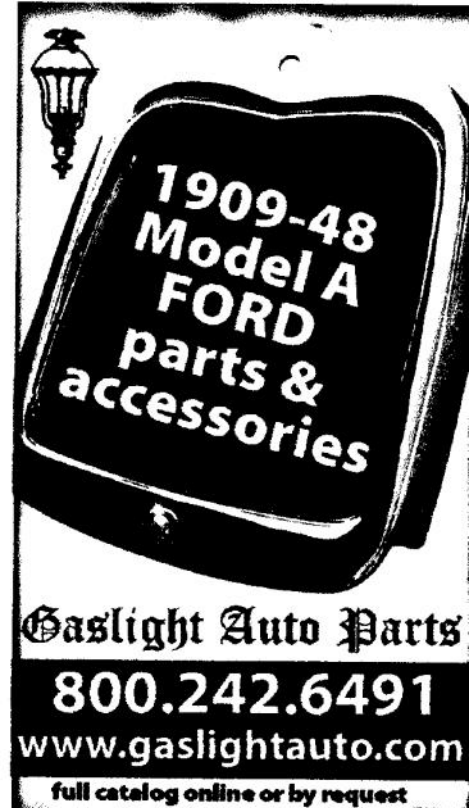

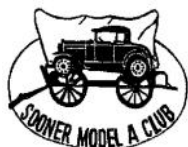
