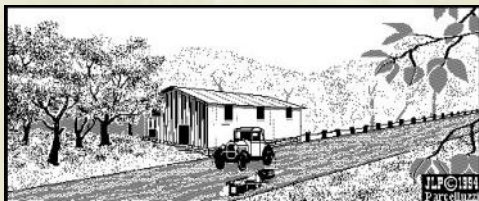
Dear Model A'ers:

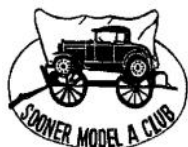
