Sounds like a good St. Patrick's Day recipe from the Cooking With Henry's Ladies cookbook put out by the Phoenix Model A Club, Phoenix, AZ.

Cabbage Casserole

- 1 lb. ground beef
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 tsp salt
- 1/8 tsp pepper
- 1/3 c. uncooked rice
- 1 can tomato soup
- 1 soup can of water
- Coarsely shredded cabbage

Brown beef and onion; add other ingredients, except cabbage, simmering for 10 min. Place enough raw cabbage to fill bottom of a 10x14" dish about halfway to top. Place other ingredients on top of cabbage. Cover and bake at 325 degrees for 1 hour. Test for doneness, as it may take a few minutes longer.
