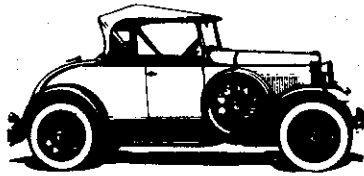

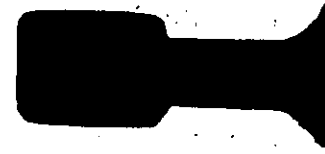

FROM THE PRESIDENTS HORN

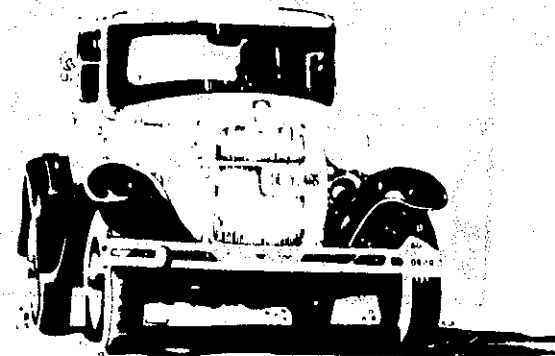

be back with us soon.

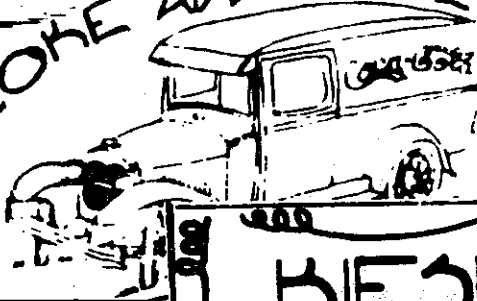

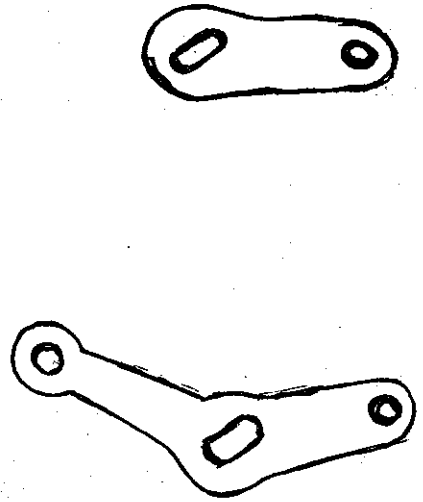
THE FORDY FIRST PSALM
